By checking your exterior, plumbing, electrical, HVAC and major appliances, you will prevent breakdowns and keep your home functional and looking beautiful.  □ Check your home for insect activity □ Check caulk around showers, bathtubs, sinks & toilets □ Mulch garden beds □ Clean kitchen hood vent filter □ Ensure ceiling fans run counter clockwise □ Clean grill & fill propane tank □ Clear lint from dryer vent 	 □ Check basement & crawl spaces for moisture or leaks □ Install storm windows and doors (as needed) □ Clean kitchen hood vent filter □ Test your sump pump □ Check painted walls & baseboards for touch up □ Ensure ceiling fans run clockwise □ Turn off outdoor faucets for the season
